Union Electric Company (d/b/a Ameren Missouri) is authorized by Article 419 of its license from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to issue permits for use and occupancy of project lands and waters. The types of use and occupancy of project lands and waters for which Ameren Missouri may grant permission are:

Boat docks, non-commercial piers, landings, or other similar structures and facilities; bank stabilization for erosion control to protect the existing shoreline; the placement or removal of dredged or fill material from or into project lands or waters; and landscape plantings.

Prior to completing this form, permit applicants are encouraged to review the requirements for Ameren Missouri permits for installation, modification, or transfer of boat docks, bank stabilization construction, decks, breakwaters, boat ramps, and any other structures including excavation and fill within the FERC project boundary for the Osage Project. Guideline booklets that address the permit requirements are available at Ameren Missouri's Shoreline Management Office or online at www.amerenmissouri.com.
